

Webb City Band Boosters

Guidelines

The Booster Club will support the philosophy of the director and provide all the students with an enriching experience and develop their talents to the highest degree of proficiency.

- Parents and booster club members are expected to follow the same standards of conduct as R-7 school district employees when chaperoning, sponsoring or attending student activities or participating in booster club events and meetings, both at home and away.
- Participation is considered to be a privilege and not a right, and will be based on a proven record of good conduct and dependability. Lack of such demonstrated behavior on the part of anyone will be grounds for disapproval for participation and travel.
- All meetings shall be public and announced in advance in accordance with the bylaws.
- A band director or designee must be present at all booster meetings.
- Any action taken at booster meetings may be subject to review and revocation of the R-7 school district.
- The regular school program and extra-curricular activities of the school and programs sanctioned by the school and district affiliated organizations will take precedence over booster activities.
- Each individual student's or group of students' participation will be determined by the director or the principal and not by the organization or any member(s).
- There will be no student activities, student parties, student meetings, student travel, or other student gathering by the Band Boosters unless said activity has been cleared through the band director or designee. All student travel or activities on school premises sanctioned by the Boosters will be under the auspices of the school district and must have a school employee present.
- Participation in any activity or travel associated with booster activities is a privilege and not a right for all involved. All student and employee travel will be under the auspices of the school and all participants will be approved by the director or designee.
- Band Boosters shall not directly support political activities by providing campaign donations or placing advertisements in support of a particular candidate as doing so could jeopardize the tax-exempt status of the organization.

All decisions concerning the activities of the Booster Club should be aimed at the welfare of the student, educationally and musically. Webb City Band Booster Club exists to provide physical and financial support for each program. The directors and administrators are responsible for establishing policies and procedures for the program.

All contract labor payments beyond \$600 annually must be reported to the IRS on Form 1099.

Internal financial reviews should be conducted every year at the conclusion of the fiscal year.

Boosters will assist with welcoming parents to the program through "student orientations".

Boosters will become education advocates and work to find ways to improve education as an organized group.
